A total of 178 different objects are represented with the names of the objects printed beneath the pictures.

Youngsters learn ABCs as they color pictures of apatosaurus, brachiosaurus, compognathus, diplodocus, and 26 other prehistoric creatures.

Although they've been extinct for eons, these mighty beasts continue to wield their power in this pocket-sized collection of activities. Kids can help a lost

Triceratops catch up with the herd, learn their ABCs coloring a Diplodocus, spot the differences in an Anatosaurus duo, and enjoy lots of other puzzles. The fun doesn't end there because each illustration can be colored!

A is for apple (and artichoke, alligator, ant, and armadillo). Queen Anne's lace, quail, and Queen conch begin with a Q, while the letter Z is the starting point for Zebra moth, zinnia, and zucchini. Along the way, from A to Z, easy-to-color pictures will introduce you to other letters of the alphabet as well as many natural wonders--from the tiny lily-of-the-valley and the amazing kangaroo, to puffy white clouds and the gentle llama. Twenty-nine pages of black-and-white drawings with identifications are accompanied by big and little letters of the alphabet.
