WRITING A PSYCHIATRIC CASE HISTORY—Auckland

Sample Mental Health Case Study-2 Rita was a 58-year-old woman whose husband had suddenly died the previous year. Her children had all grown up and left the village for better employment opportunities in a big city. She had started experiencing poor sleep and loss of appetite soon after her husband died.

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
